


### Day 1 - Delhi

#### Day 4 - Agra - Fatehpur Sikri - Jaipur

Depart for the "Land of Kings"- Jaipur 232 kms. 5 hrs. drive approx. You will be stopping after one hour to discover the deserted capital city of Fatehpur Sikri.

Arrive Jaipur, check-in to the Hotel. Overnight in hotel.

#### Day 5 - Jaipur

Full day sight-seeing of Jaipur with an excursion to the Amber Fort, overlooking the beautiful lake. You can even enjoy the exciting optional Elephant ride on your way to the Amber Fort. Overnight in hotel.

#### Day 6 - Jaipur - Delhi

Depart in the morning for Delhi - 252 kms. 5 hrs drive approx. Arrive Delhi in the afternoon, where the tour concludes.





# Royal Rajasthan - Ultimate Luxury

#### Duration of Tour -9 nights/10 days Cities covered - Delhi / Agra / Jaipur / Jodhpur / Udaipur / Mumbai

Rajasthan is located on the Northwest borders of India, where countless Rajput Warriors once ruled tiny kingdoms in the desert. With its marvelous palaces and fortresses, it is literally translated as the land of Kings & princesses. Rajasthan is the ultimate confluence of history, chivalry, romance, rugged natural beauty, art & craft and colour.

In fact, Rajasthan is India at her colourful and exotic best. The magic of Rajasthan is unequaled in the world not only for its heritage, culture, safaris, sand dunes but also for its lush green forests with its wildlife.

Day 01: Delhi - Arrive in Delhi and stay in your selected hotel. Spend the day at leisure and stay overnight in the hotel.

Day 02: Delhi - After breakfast leave for a full day tour of Old & New Delhi. You will see the splendid gates, narrow alleys, enormous Bazaars, mosques in Old Delhi. While in New Delhi, you will see the wide tree lined avenues, parks and fountains surrounding the imposing government and state buildings. Overnight stay in the hotel.

Day 03: Delhi - Agra Drive to Agra by road, which is 203 Kms/approx 4 hrs. drive away from Delhi, with a brief stopover in Sikandra Fort. Arrive Agra, check-in to the Hotel. Visit Taj Mahal, an extravagant marble monument of love built by Shahjahan in 1653 as a memorial to his Queen Mumtaz Mahal. Overnight stay in the hotel.

Day 04: Agra - Fatehpur Sikri - Jaipur - Depart for the "pink city" - Jaipur 232 kms. / 5 hrs. drive approx. You will be stopping after one hour to discover the deserted capital city of Fatehpur Sikri.

Arrive Jaipur, check-in to the Hotel. Overnight in hotel.

**Day 05 : Jaipur -** Full day sight-seeing of Jaipur, with an excursion to the Amber Fort, overlooking the beautiful lake. You can even enjoy the exciting optional Elephant ride on your way to the Amber Fort. Overnight in hotel.

Day 06: Jaipur - Jodhpur - Depart in the morning for Jodhpur - 290 kms./ 6 hrs drive. Check in to the hotel upon arrival. Day at leisure. Jodhpur is known as the gateway to the Thar desert. It lies on its Eastern edge, acting as a window to a wonderful world of the Rathore Clan in 1459.





**Day 07 : Jodhpur -** Leave for the city tour of Jodhpur to see the most spectacular fortress/palaces mainly Mehrangarh Fort and magnificent Umaid Bhavan Palace. While on the tour, you can not miss the hustle-bustle of everyday life in the Jodhpur's local markets.

Day 8: Jodhpur - Ranakpur - Udaipur - Drive to Udaipur, en-route visiting the famed Ranakpur Jain Temple, one of biggest and most important pilgrimage sites for the Jain community in India. Enjoy a boat cruise on lake Pichola in the evening.

Day 9: Udaipur - After breakfast visit the romantic city renowned as the "Venice of the East" and a fascinating place with extravagant palaces, temples, havelis and full of cultural heritage.

**Day 10 : Udaipur - Mumbai / Out - From Udaipur connect flight for Mumbai to take your connecting flight back home.** 









## Kerala - God's own Country

#### Cruising the Backwaters

#### Duration of Tour -7 nights/8 days

#### Cities covered - Cochin / Alleppey / Kumarakom / Periyar / Trivandrum / Kovalam

Exploding palms and trumpeting elephants; temple dances that thunder into the night and mysterious green backwaters flowing sensuously through the land; colorful festivals, serene churches, enchanting byways and boat races...Kerala is a land of beauty of stunning variety and often is described as God's own country.

**Day 01 : Cochin** - Fly to Cochin in the coastal state of Kerala, the Queen of the Arabian Sea. Take the Harbour cruise to visit Mantanacherry Palace, Jewish Synagogue, Vypeen and Gundu islands to see the Chinese fishing nets. Overnight stay in the hotel

#### Day 02: Cochin/Alleppey

After breakfast, drive to Alleppey which is 64 kms/ 1 ½ hrs. drive. Take the tour through the tropical countryside enchanting backwaters of Alleppey by regattas (snake boats) for which Kerala is very famous. Enjoy the sunset in the evening from the sun- deck of the houseboats, moving towards Kumarakom. Dinner and overnight at the houseboat.

**Day 03: Kumarakom** - Disembark at Kumarakom Jetty in the morning and check into your hotel. Visit the Bird Sanctuary, located on the banks of Vembanad Lake to see different species of birds. Overnight at the hotel.

**Day 04: Kumarakom - Periyar** - Drive to Periyar ( 130 kms/ 4 hrs ) and visit the Periyar Wildlife Sanctuary, one of the largest wildlife reserves in India, which covers 777 sq kms of tropical forest, with a 26 sq km large artificial lake, built by the British.

Day 05: Periyar - See different games by the boat in the sanctuary, surrounded by the hills. Then you will take a Spice Tour in the Spice plantations. Overnight at the hotel.

**Day 6 : Periyar - Trivandrum - Kovalam - Drive to Kovalam (269 kms / 6 hrs), en-route visit the Padmanabha Swamy Temple, Napier Museum, Sri Chitra Art Gallery & Museums etc. Check in to your hotel.** 

Day 07: Kovalam - Full day is free to relax on the beach. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 08: Kovalam Trivandrum / Out - Depart to Trivandrum airport to connect flight for onward destination









#### **Exotic Goa Golden Beaches**

#### Duration of Tour -4 nights/5 days

#### Cities covered - Mumbai / Goa
